

Good morning,

Governor Wolf's order calling on all non-life-sustaining businesses in Pennsylvania to close their physical locations as of 8 p.m., March 19, **does not** prohibit school districts from continuing to offer food services to children during the statewide school closure. Schools may continue to bring in essential employees involved in the preparation and distribution of meals for children. The Hollidaysburg Area School District Food Services will continue to serve meals to all children during this critical time.

All students age 18 and younger are eligible. Children must be present in order for meals to be provided. Please stay in your car, and meals will be provided to you based on the number of children in the car.
