

FREE MEALS AVAILABLE WHILE SCHOOLS ARE CLOSED



Dear Parents and Guardians:

Schools closed due the coronavirus are able to provide free meals to all students through the National School Lunch Program. These meals are available for all families and to any child age 18 or younger.

While schools are not in session, the Hollidaysburg Area School District invites families and caregivers to pick up meals for the children beginning on Thursday, March 19, 2020. A breakfast and lunch will be provided each day on a first come, first serve basis.

We are working towards opening additional pick up off sites throughout the district. Additional information will be forthcoming.

Children must be present in order for meals to be provided. Please stay in your car, and meals will be provided to you based on the number of children in the car.

Families that live close to the site may walk to pick up their meals but are asked not to congregate at the pick-up site.

Lunch will include a sandwich, fresh vegetable, fruit, and milk. Cereal, yogurt, or a muffin/bread, are examples of items that may be provided for breakfast. Breakfast will also include fruit, juice and milk.

We encourage families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of coronavirus by not congregating at the pick-up site once meals have been distributed, continue to wash your hands often, use a tissue when sneezing or coughing, and stay at home if you are sick.
