Student Drop Off & Picking Up

For safety reasons and due to the confusion of bus traffic at the beginning of each day students will not be permitted to be dropped off at the front doors between the hours of 8:30 am and 9:00 am.

Students being privately transported to school should be dropped off at the side door and will be permitted to enter the building at **8:40 a.m.** If your son/daughter is eating breakfast, they will be sent directly to the cafeteria. *Please do not drop your son/daughter off prior to 8:40 a.m. as there is not staff assigned to supervise children prior to 8:40 a.m.* Thank you for your help with this matter!

If the need arises that you would have to pick up your child at the end of the school day (**randomly/unexpectedly**), we ask that you park in the parking lot and come into the office to sign your child out. These students will then be called down for dismissal at 3:15 PM.

If you know in the **morning** that you will need to pick up your child at the end of the day, please send a note to school to be given to your child's teacher. This note will be sent to the office, and they will be released at the side door at 3:20 PM. When arriving at the school, please pull into the "cars & walkers" car line and wait to pull up to the side door.
